End of Key Stage SATS

SATs week for our current Year 6 children will take place in the week beginning Tuesday 8th May 2023. National testing for Year 2 children will take place during the month of May 2023. The Year 1 Phonics check will take place during June and the Year 4 multiplication check from Monday 3rd June.

To commemorate this occasion, on Friday 5th May we would like children to come to school dressed in red, white and blue (or they could even dress as a member of the royal family!).

In classes during the day, children will be making crowns and flags and taking part in other fun activities. Children will also be making banners and bunting to display in school. At 12.30pm we will all go out into the school grounds (weather permitting) and have a picnic and a good old-fashioned party!
