Dear Parents and Carers,

We are now four weeks into the new term and all of our new children have all settled into school routines so well. #### New EYFS parents (2023 intake) Open Evening

Do you have a child who is due to start school in September 2024? Choosing your child's school is an important decision. This evening is aimed at giving new parents as much information as possible in order to help them make the right decision. Our Open Evening will take place on **Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October at 6.30pm**. There will a chance to tour our amazing EYFS base and talk informally to staff. We will be advertising this event locally, but if you or someone you know is interested in attending, they can book a place by contacting the school office.



#### **Phonics Workshop**

On **Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> September**, we are holding our first phonics workshop for parents of children in current EYFS. The workshop starts at **9.00am** in the school hall. EYFS parents have been sent a letter separately.

#### Harvest Festival 2023

We are really looking forward to joining together this year to celebrate Harvest. This year's celebration will involve **EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 children** and will take place on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October in the school hall. This year parents evening will take place on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October and Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October, the meetings will take place in school and you will also be able to look at your children's books. A short Settling in Report will be sent home on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September- this will be discussed during the parents evening. You will be sent more information about how to book your appointment shortly.

# Attendance

Attendance has been very good so far this term. Thank you for your help in making sure that your children attend school and arrive on time. Punctuality is really important.



Doors open at 8.30am and **close at 8.45am.** Children arriving after that time will need to enter via the office. Many classes undertake important learning first thing in the morning whilst the children are bright and fresh and it can be unsettling for children who arrive late. If your child is unable to attend school, it is vitally important that you inform us of this and let us know *why*, before 9.00am on the day of absence. Please also arrive promptly to collect your child(ren) at 3.15pm. Please email <u>office@donisthorpe.leics.sch.uk</u> or call the school, giving your child's name, class and a brief reason for absence.

Any absence (including lateness) affects the pattern of a child's schooling and regular absence can seriously affect their learning. Ensuring your child's regular attendance at school is your legal responsibility and permitting absence from school without a good reason is an offence in law.

# **School Uniform**

It is our priority to ensure that school uniform is of low cost and that parents are able to access second hand uniform. We aim to ensure that our uniform is accessible to all in the following ways:

- Parents may opt for their children to wear plain or logo/branded uniform. Plain uniform is available from all supermarkets and other suppliers at a low cost.
- Logo/branded uniform can be purchased from one of our two suppliers, at a low cost.
- The school holds a small stock of second-hand uniform in all sizes. Parents should speak to the office or their child's class teacher at any time.
- Pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium funding are offered support with uniform costs. Parents should speak to the office or their child's class teacher at any time.
- We encourage families to pass uniform down through siblings and friends.

Please see our suppliers below, for uniform with our logo on, however it is not a requirement for children to wear branded uniform. As such, uniform can be purchased from any supermarket at a low cost.

# Apply for a School Place Secondary

It is fast approaching the time when Year 6 parents need to apply for secondary school places for their children. To assist you in this, the feeder



secondary schools (Ivanhoe School, Ashby School, Ibstock Community College Information concerning these schools is available from the individual establishments) will hold open evenings over the next few weeks.



I want to stress the importance of **applying for** <u>three schools</u>. Some children in the past, have been left without a secondary school place on offer day as parents had only listed one school. Secondary admissions closing date is 31<sup>st</sup> October, and national offer date 1<sup>st</sup> March (*or next working day*).
