We also offer snacks during the afternoon sessions, whilst so far, they have been a success, we understand that not everybody likes the same things. so that being said- if there's anything your child would like to bring from home, that's no problem at all! They can bring them to the room in the morning and I will store them appropriately during the day, this applies to morning and afternoon sessions. There are a few parents who do this already, so having a labelled bag would be wonderful! **(please note that for food hygiene reasons, we are unfortunately not allowed to heat or reheat any foods from home, so cold snacks are most ideal!)**

Regarding bringing toys from home, again, we will never say no (electronics excluded of course!) but we do urge to children that it must be their responsibility to ensure their toy is kept either in their bag or in the room during the day and not used during school hours, breaks included, and that they must ask parents first. We ask this because we are unable to replace damaged property and would hate for your child to be upset in such a situation.
