Maths

This half term, we will start looking at place value to 20.

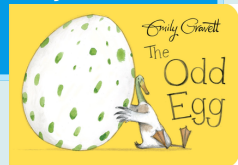
Children will look at:

- counting to 20
- numbers 11-20 and their value
- one more and one less
- number lines
- ordering numbers
- comparing numbers



English

This half term, we will be looking at the book 'The Odd Egg' by Emily Gravett. During this unit, we will be focusing on non-fiction reports, imperative verbs as well as continuing with our focus on adjectives.



Science

This half term we will be starting a new unit. During the Spring term we will be looking at animals, including humans.

Children will look at:

- fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals
- carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
- basic parts of the human body
- the five senses



Geography

We will be starting a new unit called 'My World and Me'.

Within this unit the children will look at:

- naming the five oceans
- the equator and the poles
- human and physical features
- animals from around the world

This half term we will be learning the following new sounds:

D&T

During this half term in Design & Technology, the children will be looking at structures. Within this unit of work, the children will be designing, making and evaluating a puppet.



PSHE

In PSHE this half term, we will be looking at:

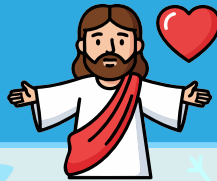
- appropriate contact

RE

This half term the children will be looking at Jesus. We will look at stories about Jesus including:

- the story of feeding the 5000
- healing the blind man.



Computing

We will continue looking at spreadsheets.

The children will be:

- looking at what a spreadsheet looks like
- entering data into spreadsheet cells
- using 2Calculate to create a spreadsheet



PE

Outdoor PE will be on a Monday morning and the children will need to come to school in their outdoor PE kits. During these sessions, the children will continue focusing on multi skills.

On a Tuesday, the children will have PE with myself, where the children will get changed in school, so please ensure their PE kits are in school. In these sessions, we will be focusing on ball skills during these sessions.
